







CAQ in Occupational Medicine...update

The Bureau of Osteopathic Specialists (BOS) Standards Review committee (SRC) is currently reviewing the CAQ in Occupational Medicine; however,

"any changes to the Certificate of Added Qualification (CAQ) in Occupational Medicine that will be made by the AOA Bureau of Osteopathic Specialists (BOS) Standards Review committee (SRC) will not affect those physicians who are currently enrolled in the Occupational Medicine Basic Course. That means that those physicians taking the Occupational Medicine Basic Course now will still be eligible to get the Occupational Medicine CAQ under the current eligibility and requirements as listed in the American Osteopathic Board of Preventive Medicine web site: <https://certification.osteopathic.org/preventive-medicine/certification-process/occupational-medicine/certification-exam/>"
