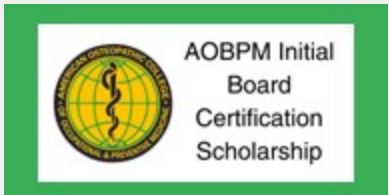
Make Mentorship Connections
