## 2027 Midyear Educational Conference and OPAM Workshop: Basic Course in Occupational Medicine, Part I

### Event Venue Summary Omni Oklahoma City | March 3–7, 2027



Key highlights of the Omni Oklahoma City and surrounding area:

- **Venue** — The Omni Oklahoma City is a newer, in-demand property in a convenient downtown-adjacent location, offering a polished, professional environment for our Midyear Conference attendees.
- **Location** — The hotel directly overlooks the iconic Scissortail Park and is steps from the Paycom Center (the home of the OKC Thunder). The on-site sports bar (far away from meeting space to prevent any noise interference) is a popular Thunder watch destination, offering attendees built-in evening entertainment.
- **Nearby attractions** – The Omni is walking distance from popular downtown attractions such as the Bricktown District, the Myriad Botanical Gardens, and the Oklahoma City Museum of Art. Dining options in the area are numerous and diverse, offering classic American fare and international options such as Peruvian and Laotian cuisine (see map and recommendations provided below).
- **Discounted group room rate** — Negotiated guestroom rate of \$229/night.
- **Complimentary deluxe Wi-Fi Concession** — Deluxe Wi-Fi at no charge in all guestrooms.
- **Ideal meeting space layout** — AOCOPM's meeting space will include a main didactic session room and an adjacent flexible multipurpose room, ideal for OMM tables, a between-session attendee lounge area, and the faculty/fellow convocation reception. Attendees will enjoy the ease of navigating one central meeting space.
- **Affordable parking options** — Parking in the surrounding area offers less expensive options than other, older venues in the heart of downtown. Daily parking is available in nearby lots for approximately \$10, with overnight valet at the hotel offered at \$39.

# HOW TO RIDE & SERVICE INFORMATION

## SCHEDULES

### Downtown Loop

Mon - Thurs: 6am - 12am  
Friday: 6am - 2am  
Saturday: 7am - 2am  
Sunday: 7am - 10pm

### Bricktown Loop

Friday: 6am - 2am  
Saturday: 7am - 2am  
Sunday: 7am - 10pm

## BOARDING & RIDING

### 1 Preparing:

Know where you're going. All rides start and end on a streetcar platform. Review a map and check arrival times by platform at [realtime.okcstreetcar.com](http://realtime.okcstreetcar.com) When you arrive on a platform, check the screen for arrival times and/or service notices.

### 2 Boarding:

With level boarding, it's easy getting on a streetcar. All streetcars and platforms are ADA accessible. When the streetcar comes to a complete stop, please allow for departing riders to exit the streetcar first, then board. If no one is exiting, press the yellow door button to open the doors. Grab a seat or hold on to a handrail/strap. Don't forget, leave priority seating for those who need it. And of course, never block the doors.

### 3 Riding:

Once you're on your way, check your phone, listen to your headphones or chat with people you see every day, but stay aware of what stops you're approaching. We'll help with on-board stop announcements. If you need off, simply press a blue stop button or the yellow door button to request the next stop. The streetcar will not stop at platforms unless a stop is requested.

### 4 Arriving:

As you approach your destination, wait for the streetcar to come to a complete stop. Grab your things and head out. Push the yellow door button to open the doors, then exit. After you exit the platform, remember to look before you cross and always use crosswalks.

Riders can enjoy six months of free OKC Streetcar service as part of a pilot initiative to continue ridership growth.

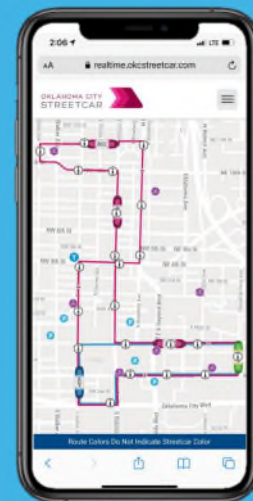
